First Sunday Mission Offering

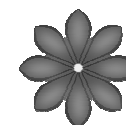

Each month, the Mission Team will provide information about that month's mission project and report on the collection from the previous month. Thank you all for your faithful generosity!

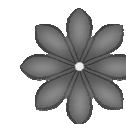
2017 Flower Calendar
