

## June First Sunday Mission Offering



June's First Sunday Mission Offering benefits the Jean B. Purvis Community Health Center, located at 103 Bonnie Drive. The center is a nonprofit, community-based volunteer organization which provides medical care, basic dental care, behavioral health services, and health and wellness education for our income-eligible neighbors, ages 19-64, in Butler County.

The needs within our community are substantial. In 2020, the center provided care for more than 1,200 patients. Many patients suffer from longstanding illnesses, such as diabetes, hypertension, asthma, lung disorders and other problems that can become acute without regular care. It takes \$1,300 a day to keep the center running. To help, simply place your donation in a "First Sunday Mission Offering" envelope from the pew racks or write "Community Health Center" on the memo line of your check. Thank you!

## Stand with Ukraine

The Russian invasion of Ukraine has sparked the worst humanitarian crisis in Europe since World War II. More than 5 million Ukrainians have fled to neighboring countries. Presbyterian Disaster Assistance (the emergency response and refugee agency of our denomination) is partnering with other organizations to help.

A PDA update says, "In the midst of the chaos, sibling churches and ecumenical partners are providing assistance with basic items for survival. While the scale of this crisis is new, receiving refugees from Ukraine and other countries in Central and Eastern Europe is not, which means we have trusted, established partners with the knowledge and expertise to carry out this important work. Funds are being used for emergency humanitarian aid such as food items, shelter, medicines, diapers, hygiene items, etc."
